CONSIDERATION OF REPLACEMENT FLOW METERS AT WELL FIELD	In 2015, 9 electronic flow mag meters were purchased from Mid America Meter. 3 of the 9 flow meters have now failed due to repeated submergence, which has caused the weather stripping to fail, filling the control pods up with water. These pods contain the brains that submit the flow readings up to SCADA. Received a quote for Mid America Meter to replace 3 meters at a price of \$10,111.72, to include podding kits, wall mounting kits, and 300 feet of wire. Upon motion from Director Norris, seconded by Director Peterson, motion passed 5-0 <b>RESOLVED (No. 15349),</b> that the Board approved the purchase of 3 flow meters and accessories from Mid America Meter for \$10,111.72.
