CONSIDERATION OF CHEMICAL FEED PUMPS

Both plants use peristaltic feed pumps to feed chemicals as part of the treatment process. The current chemical feed pumps were purchased in 2014. Received two quotes for the same model, the A3 series, four model A3V24-MND pumps for ammonia and 15 model A#V24-MNKL pumps for all the other chemicals. Hawkins quoted \$86,200.00 includes shipping cost for 19 pumps A3V24. USA Bluebook quoted \$87,583.61. Upon motion from Director Norris, seconded by Director Peterson, motion passed 5-0...

RESOLVED (No. 15378), that the Board approved to purchase chemical feed pumps from Hawkins for \$86,200, for \$43,100 for each plant.

CONSIDERATION OF PHONE EQUIPMENT PURCHASE

This year AT&T is encouraging us to upgrade from analog to a digial service. They offered a five year digital plan to replace the existing phones for \$592 per month for 60 months (\$35,520 total) or an upfront purchase price of \$30,024.40. This would include phones, installation, training, warranty.
